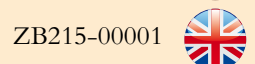

CROCHET HOOK

10mm (no 000) (US N15) crochet hook

TENSION

10½ sts and 14 rows to 10 cm measured over dc fabric using 10mm (US N15) crochet hook.

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **dc2tog** = (insert hook as indicated, yoh and draw loop through) twice, yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook; **yoh** = yarn over hook.

BACK and FRONT (both alike)

Using 10mm (US N15) crochet hook make 64 [70: 74: 80: 86] ch.

Row 1 (RS): 1 dc into 2nd ch from hook, 1 dc into each ch to end, turn. 63 [69: 73: 79: 85] sts.

Row 2: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each dc to end, turn.

Last row forms dc fabric.

Cont in dc fabric until work meas 54 [56: 57: 59: 60] cm, ending with RS [RS: **WS**: **WS**: RS] facing for next row.

Shape neck

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each of first 22 [25: 27: 30: 34] dc and turn, leaving rem sts unworked.

Work each side of neck separately.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into first dc, dc2tog over next 2 sts, 1 dc into each dc to end, turn.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each dc to last 3 sts, dc2tog over next 2 sts, 1 dc into last st, turn.

20 [23: 25: 28: 32] sts.

Rep last 2 rows 1 [1: 1: 1: 2] times more, then first of these rows 0 [0: 1: 1: 0] times more, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

18 [21: 22: 25: 28] sts.

Work 1 row.

Fasten off.

Return to last complete row worked, miss centre 19 [19: 19: 19: 17] dc, rejoin yarn to next dc and cont as folls:

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each dc to end, turn. 22 [25: 27: 30: 34] sts.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into each dc to last 3 sts, dc2tog over next 2 sts, 1 dc into last st, turn.

Next row: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into first dc, dc2tog over next 2 sts, 1 dc into each dc to end, turn. 20 [23: 25: 28: 32] sts.

Rep last 2 rows 1 [1: 1: 1: 2] times more, then first of these rows 0 [0: 1: 1: 0] times more, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

18 [21: 22: 25: 28] sts.

Work 1 row.

Fasten off.

MAKING UP

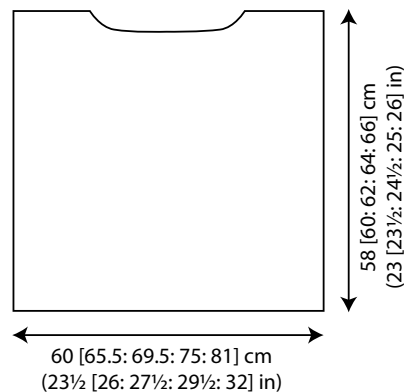
Press as described on the information page.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch.

Place markers along side seam edges 28 [29.5: 31: 32.5: 34] cm either side of shoulder seams (to denote base of armhole openings).

Join side seams from markers to a point 6 cm below markers, leaving side seams open below this point.
